Dear Deputy Smyth,

I refer to Parliamentary Question No. 17929/19.

To ask the Minister for Transport; Tourism and Sport the number of persons to date on waiting lists for driver tests in counties Cavan and Monaghan; the length of time they have been waiting in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

The Minister has referred the Parliamentary Question to my Office for response and the detail is set out in the Table below as at Monday 22 April.

Cavan	232	382	358	6.6	11
Monaghan	199	146	175	6.1	12

The target average wait time is ten weeks and in any test centre where the average wait time is greater than this we are assigning additional resources to reduce the average wait times to ten weeks or below.
